

## **Act 4—The Coming of the King: Redemption Accomplished**

### ***Week Twenty-Three***

Subject: The Gospel

Bible Reading: Luke 24 and John 20

Read: Luke 24: 13-27, 36-49; John 20:10-18, 19-23

1. Explain the events taking place in this first part of chapter 24. What, if anything, stands out to you in this passage? (vs. 13-27)
2. Now read Luke 24:36-49. What is happening here? What is meant by verses 47-49?
3. Does anything resonate with you in this passage of John 20:10-18?
4. In John 20:15, Mary is talking to Jesus but thinks he is someone else. However, in vs. 16, Jesus calls Mary by her name. The scripture says that she then knew who he was. Is this significant? Why or why not?
5. What does it mean for Jesus to call you by name?
6. What do you see happening in John 20:19-23? Where is Jesus sending them?
7. What does it mean that Jesus breathed on them?
8. Jesus is the giver of life. Where do you see this in the gospel and where do you see this in your own life?
