Subject: The Great Commissions

Bible Reading: Matthew 28, Mark 16:15-16, Luke 24:45-49, John 20:21

Read: Matthew 28:16-20, Mark 16:15-16, Luke 24:45-49, John 20:21

1. After reading Matt. 28:16-20, read Matt. 4:12-17. What is the common factor in both where Jesus began his ministry and where he ended his ministry? What is significant about this commonality?
2. Verse 17 tells us that when the 11 disciples saw Jesus, they worshiped him. What does it mean to worship Jesus?
3. Who are “all nations” and what does this reveal about Jesus` purpose in coming (cf; Matt. 4:12-17 again)?
4. What does making a disciple look like according to Matt. 28:19-20?
5. Jesus reveals a promise in Matt. 28:20. What is this promise and what does it meant o you?
6. What is the great commission message found in Mark 16:15?
7. What is the great commission message found in Luke 24:45-49?
8. What is the great commission message found in John 20:21?
9. What do these 4 commission statements we`ve read tonight, tell you about God`s heart and concern for the world?
10. How do you fit into this picture of making disciples, proclaiming (preaching) God`s love, living as a witness to truth and participating in `going` into all nations?
