Subject: 1 Peter

Bible Reading: 1 Peter

Read: 1 Pt. 1-9; 13-2:3; 2:9-12; 3:8-17; 4:7-16

1. Who is Peter writing to?
2. What stands out to you in this 1<sup>st</sup> passage? Why?
3. What do you think it means to have a living hope? What does this look like in your life?
4. What does it mean to be holy? What is meant by living as strangers in the world in 1:17b?
5. Read 2:9-12. Are there some things that you do or a way you do something that looks wrong to those who don't have a relationship with Christ, but you know is right because you are holy? Talk about some of those things.
6. Now read Peter's words in 3:8-17. What are your thoughts on this idea of suffering for doing good?
7. Talk about the ways we are to live for God found in 4:7-11. Ask every one in your group to commit to working on one of these over the next week as they see fitting.
8. What themes do you find in our readings tonight of 1 Pt?
9. What are the ways that you relate to what we've talked about in the scriptures?
